



Everybody's Talking

On the street, people are walking and talking on their cell phones. In cars, people are driving and talking. In offices, people are working and talking on the phone.

Finland was the first country in the world with cell phones. The largest cell phone company in the world is in Finland. Now, there are more than four billion cell phones in the world. China has more cell phones than any other country. In many countries, there are more cell phones than people. For example, there are more cell phones than people in Hong Kong and Portugal. Many people have two cell



phones, one for home and one for work. People use their cell phones for many things. They play games, listen to music, take photographs, and use the Internet. In Japan, people are using cell phones to learn English.

Teachers are not happy about cell phones. When they are teaching, cell phones ring. Sometimes, students text message each other. They text message one another during tests! In many schools, students cannot bring their cell phones to class. In other schools, students must turn off their cell phones before class.






