

# **ONLINE TEACHING ROUTINE: VOCABULARY**

## **Before Class**

- **Connect with students** by sending them a message or short video with instructions to:
  - o **preview** the unit's vocabulary by looking at the photos in the **Student's Book**.
  - **listen** to the vocabulary **audio track** as they look at the photos.

# In Class

- **Build community.** Allow time for students to **greet** you and one another. Have them **share** any news since the previous class.
- **Mute** all students before beginning instruction. **Unmute** as needed throughout the class.
- **Display** the vocabulary on the **CPT** (:).
- Have students **open** their **Student's Books** to the vocabulary lesson.
- Use the **zoom feature** to **display** each vocabulary word on the **CPT**. As you zoom on each photo, clearly **pronounce** and **give a student-friendly definition** for each word.
- Play the audio (:) and have students repeat the words with the narrator.
- **Unmute** all students and have them chorally **say** the words as you zoom in on each photo.
- **Show** each photo again. This time **unmute** one student at a time and have the student say the word.
- Be sure to have students **take a short brain break** at some point during the class. Play a song, game, or video to gets students up and moving for around one minute.

#### Wrap Up

- **Review instructions** for the **practice activities** on the **CPT** (:). Answer any questions students have before ending the lesson.
- Build community. End the class by unmuting students and having them say goodbye to one another and to you. Invite them to share any exciting plans they have between now and the next class.
- Ask students to prepare for the next lesson and preview the next page in the Student's Book.

#### **After Class**

- Have students complete practice activities independently. Have them take a photo of their work and email it to you or upload it to your online classroom.
- Have students connect with their partner using videoconferencing or telephone to complete personalized or open-ended activities.

## **Additional Practice**

- Have students **personalize** the activities and develop their understanding of vocabulary words by:
  - o completing a graphic organizer, such as a Venn diagram or a word web.
  - having partners take part in a Think / Pair / Share routine. (Partners write out responses to a question or questions, take time to discuss, and then share during the next class.)
