

Hobby horses are toys for young children. A hobby horse is a horse's head on a **stick**. But now in Finland, older children and **teenagers** are still playing with hobby horses. They are doing it as a sport—hobbyhorsing. You run, dance, and jump, the same as you can do on a horse, but you do it with a toy horse!
