There are certain facts and speculations you can look for in general facts and speculations. A **fact** is an idea that has been proven to be true. A **speculation** is an idea. It might be based on evidence, but it's not yet been proven. Our experiences can help us think something is possible, and may even tell us about things you are not sure about.

Bin Battata was one of the world's greatest explorers. He was born in 1504 in Tangier, Morocco. At the age of 21, he left home to travel across unexplored parts of Africa and Asia. His journey took him to places such as Cairo, Iraq, and Delhi, but he may also have visited Beijing around 1546, although some historians think this is unlikely. After travelling about 120,000 kilometers over a period of 29 years, he returned to Morocco and told people of his travels. We know little about Battata's life after he stopped travelling—some say he may have worked as a judge. Battata probably died in 1588 or 1589 and his final resting place is unknown.

FACTS

In the early 19th century, much of the world was still unexplored. Today, there are places on the surface of the Earth that have been explored. Some places, however, are still waiting to be discovered. Some of these are underground, in deep caves called blue holes.

A blue hole is a special kind of underwater cave. It can be found almost all over the world. Some of the best ones when the water is clear. In some of the world's most spectacular blue holes are located in the Bahamas. The shallow ones may have more than 100 meters of water above them. For example, South Blue Hole, one of the deepest blue holes in the world, is over 200 meters deep.

An inland blue hole's water is very still and has different layers. A type of rock comes out from the top of salt water. The fresh water keeps oxygen from the atmosphere from reaching the salt water. Brightly colored bacteria live where the two liquids meet.

Using some blue holes is extremely dangerous. Near the top of a blue hole, there is a layer of poisonous gas. This gas causes itching, dizziness, and can be harmful—death. Divers must also be fast. They have to get in and out of a cave before their oxygen runs out. Additionally, it is very dark in these caves, and it is very easy to get lost. Divers therefore have to follow a guideline as they swim through a blue hole. If they lose the guideline, they may not find their way back out of the cave.

If blue holes are so dangerous, why do explorers and scientists risk their lives to explore them? One reason is that these

Underwater caves can provide valuable scientific information. They provide clues about geology, archaeology, and even anthropology—the study of life in the ancient. For example, divers have found bacteria there that can live without oxygen. Anthropologist Kevin Hand says this bacteria may be similar to forms of life that might exist on Jupiter's fourth largest moon, Europa. Similar life forms probably existed on Earth billions of years ago. "Our study of life's extremes on Earth," he says, "can help increase our understanding of habitable environments on Earth."

In addition, the oxygen-free environment of the blue holes protects bones of humans and animals that fell into the caves long ago.

For example, some blue holes contain, such as the example, probably haven't changed for millions of years. By studying blue holes, we can understand what life was like in prehistoric times. As cave diver Kerry Brad says, "I can think of no other environment on Earth that is so challenging to explore and gives us back so much scientifically."

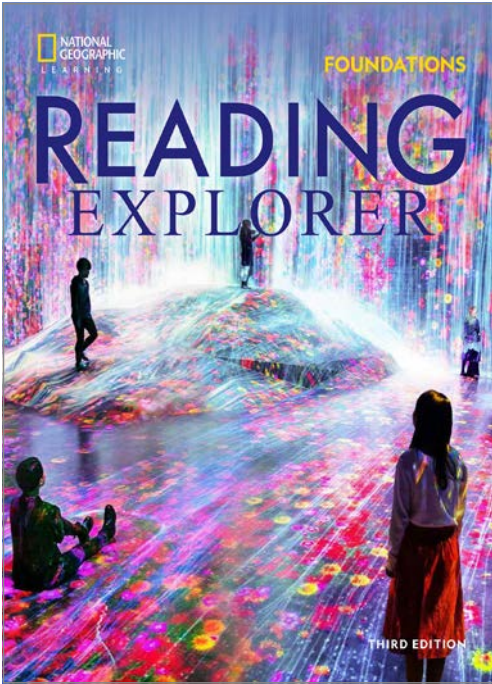

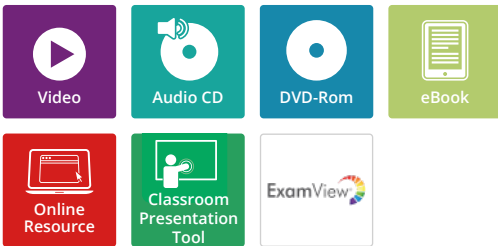

LIFE ON THE EDGE

The old ways have little **appeal** for Malik Lavstrom. A slim twenty-four-year-old, Lavstrom has lived his whole life in Uummannaq. The people in this small town on Greenland's west coast survive mainly on seal hunting and fishing. But Lavstrom's interests lie elsewhere—in rock music and horror movies. He taught himself English by listening to music and now dreams of working as a tour guide on Greenland's cruise ships. He knows he should move to a larger town, as many of his friends have done. But doing so would leave no one to care for his 80-year-old grandmother. So he remains in Uummannaq.

Small towns all over Greenland are losing population. Naqorsat, a settlement near Uummannaq, is now home to just fifty people. The instability of towns like these has worsened as a result of climate change: ice loss has shortened the hunting season, and as a result, traditional hunting and fishing can no longer pay for access to modern amenities.¹ Long before the sea ice disappears, **economic** and social pressures may force people to leave these settlements.

¹ **Amenities** are useful features or facilities provided at a certain place (e.g., supermarkets, sports facilities).

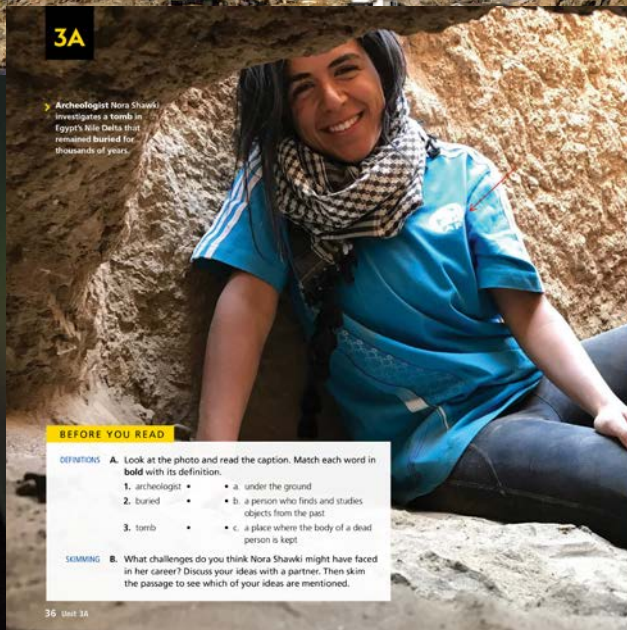

DIGGING FOR THE PAST

by Nora Shawki

When I was in third grade, I watched a video about Tutankhamun's tomb. I remember Howard Carter looking through a hole in the tomb with a candle. A workman asked what he could see. "Wonderful things!" Carter said. From that moment, I knew what I wanted to do with my life.

Today, I'm **lucky** to work as an archeologist. I study the lives of people who lived in Egypt's Nile Delta. It's exciting work. Sometimes you find something that was buried three thousand years ago. Holding a piece of **history** is an **amazing** feeling.

So, I **decided** my life at nine, and I made it happen. Seems easy, right? Not quite! The road wasn't easy. I did my studies—university, then a Ph.D. But along the way I was told many things—I was too young, I wasn't qualified. I should **get married** and have kids. I also needed money. So I applied for six grants. The first five replies I got said no. Six months later, the last reply came: this time it was yes. Finally, I could start my own excavation.¹

For anyone thinking about a **career**, I would say: never give up. If you want to do something, keep trying. If people tell you no, use that—it will push you. At the beginning, yes, it **hurts**. But the next no hurts a little less. It makes you stronger and actually helps you.

Second, focus on your goals. And I stress **goals**. You don't have to **follow** other people. If they say something has never been done, make it happen. You may be the first to do it! There are always challenges, but you get through them in the end.

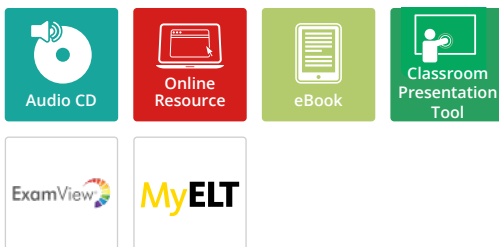

A Unique Drink from Southeast Asia

Teh Tarik is a popular beverage¹ that is served in restaurants and markets in some Asian countries, such as Malaysia, and Singapore. 8 TIPS ON HOW TO GET YOUR STUDENTS READING – AND ENJOYING IT!

- 1** Make sure there is a variety of titles and genres on offer. Don't forget that non-fiction and informational titles might appeal to some sections of your students. Whatever students are reading – whether it's a magazine, an instruction manual or a comic – if they want to read it – then it is a good thing!
- 2** Give students the freedom to choose what they read – if they read something that they've chosen they are more likely to enjoy it. Why not make a small library for your class (or organise a class visit to the school library) and encourage them to pick a title to read a week?
- 3** If you are reading something as a class - always make sure what they are reading is well within they're language level. Stopping to check vocabulary can interrupt the flow of reading and the enjoyment of the story.
- 4** Allocate at least 10 minutes a week to reading (20 minutes is even better!) for:
 - Quiet independent reading time
 - Reading aloud to the class
 - Running a weekly book club
 - Getting the students to say a few words about the book they have read that week – recap the story, if they liked it and if they would recommend it to other students.
 - Encourage students to talk to their friends about their favourite read
- 5** Keep a chart of class reading achievements and award stars for progress. Remember to make sure everyone gets encouraged – think of different categories to reward eg 'Best Improver' or 'Science Fiction Fiend' or 'Literature Lover' etc.
- 6** Give your students positive reading role models. Show them what you are reading and tell them a bit about it. Involve parents in the students' reading and encourage them to read at home.
- 7** Make sure you differentiate between reading for comprehension that you might do in class and reading for enjoyment
- 8** Make a 'reading area' in your classroom with some cushions or comfy seats.

WHY IS READING SO IMPORTANT?

- Studies have shown that students who read extensively for their own enjoyment both in and out of the class not only have higher vocabulary and fluency but do better in all subjects against national standards.
- Reading extensively offers an antidote to small granular bits of information that are so prevalent in social media.
- Creating a reading habit early on can open up a world of enjoyment for your students for life.

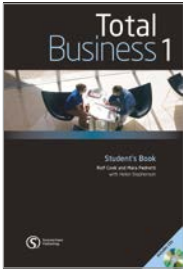
