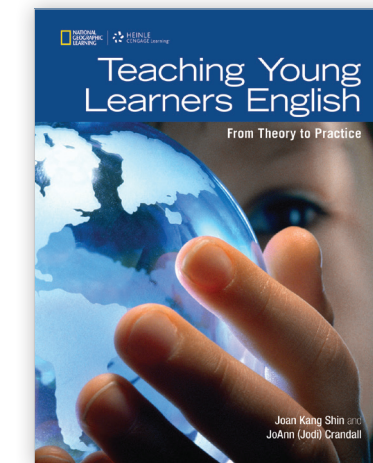
- Topics include lesson planning, classroom management, assessment, and on-going professional development.
